- Be accepted into a college program (minimum of 2 years)

The names of all applicants will be placed into a pool and shall be chosen by the Board of Directors of the BAJSS of New England, Inc. The award winners and their parents will be invited to a recognition ceremony to take place at a date and time to be announced.
